The Rocks is the birthplace of European Australia. On this rocky peninsula, in 1788, British convicts replaced the traditional way of life of the original inhabitants, the Cadigal people.

It became a melting pot of colonial life. Sailors of the world were welcomed to haunts of entertainment and friendly company as the rugged Rocks took on all the characteristics of a dockside area.

The close link with this city's maritime past remained until the recent period of restoration.
